### Suggested Citations for CAST Project Materials

#### **1. Entire website (not a specific page or document)**

Give the address of the site in the text.

***Example:***

The CAST website can be accessed by Bethel School District parents (<https://cast.ori.org>).

#### **2. Single web page**

Include title (or short title in quotes) and date retrieved.

***Example in text:***

(Information Sources, 2010)

***Example in reference list:***

Information sources. Retrieved August 12, 2010, from <https://cast.ori.org/node/418>

#### **3. Website material with author**

Include date if given (if no date, use "n.d.").

***Example in text:***

(Boles, 2010)

***Example in reference list:***

Boles, S. M. (2010). *CAST BMI summaries 0809*. Retrieved from <https://cast.ori.org/files/bmi0809displays.pdf>

#### **4. Website material with no author (document, report, map)**

Include date if given (if no date, use "n.d.").

***Example in text:***

("Ammenities\_ClearLake," 2010)

***Example in reference list:***

Ammenities\_BySchool\_ClearLake-web. (2010). Retrieved from [https://cast.ori.org/files/Ammenities\\_BySchool\\_ClearLake-web.pdf](https://cast.ori.org/files/Ammenities_BySchool_ClearLake-web.pdf)
